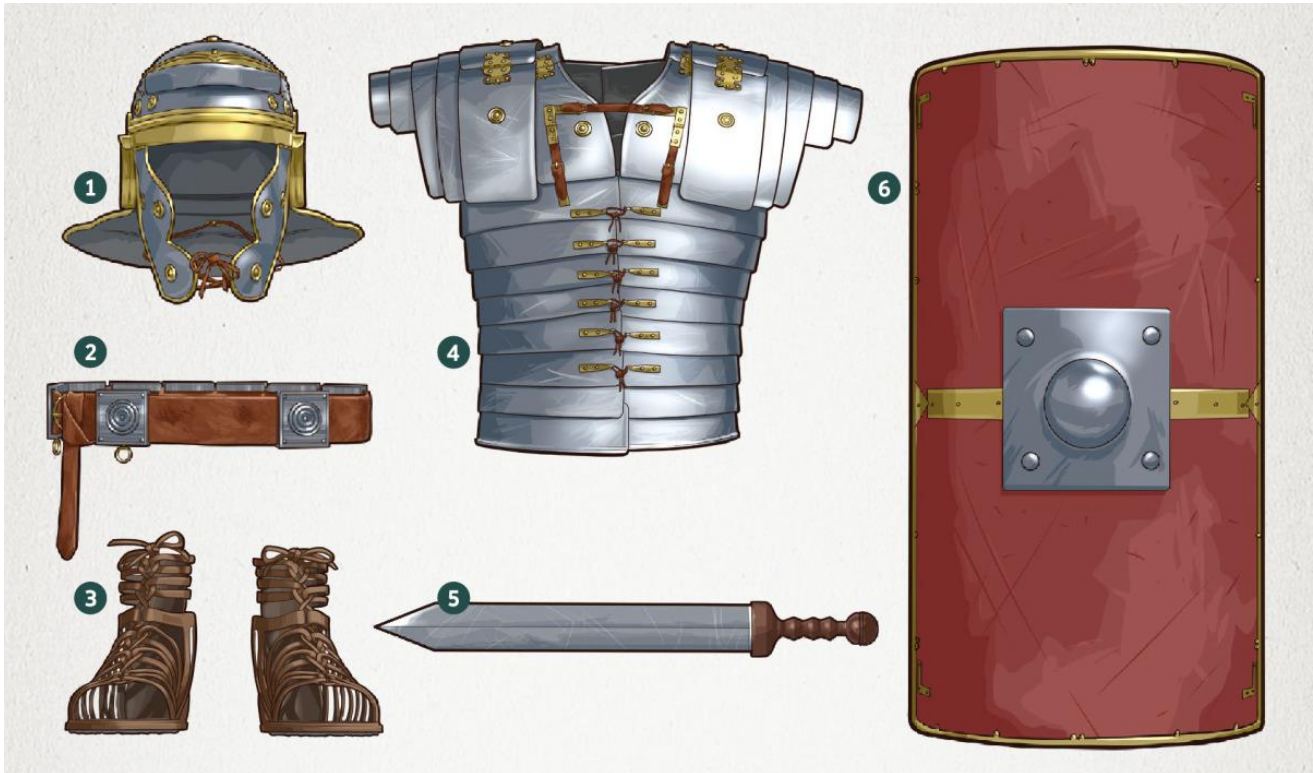

Drive the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God, into the cracks of the fortress. The Word is alive and effective, sharper than any two-edged sword. She discovers the intention and thought of the heart. Name the word that is directly opposed to the lie supporting the fortress.

Raise the shield of faith to extinguish all the fiery darts of the enemy. Faith is your protection and enables you to remain steadfast in the face of the onslaught of thoughts and accusations that seek to fortify the walls of your opponent.

Take a step back in prayer. Fortresses operate in high areas of controversy against God. Reverse these arguments by ascending into the heavenly places in prayer, where Christ sits at the right hand of God.

Confess your sins and those of your lineage, for sometimes fortresses are the product of legal rights given by past sin. Sincere confession entails the purification and breaking of the chains that solidify these strongholds.

Proclaim liberating truths about your life and those you pray for. Declare that you are a new creation in Christ, that the old is past, that everything has become new. These proclamations weaken the foundations of the fortresses.

Finally, act in accordance with prayer. Prayer without concrete action is fruitless. If the fortress is about an addiction, seek support, avoid temptations. Your actions should be a reflection of your faith and dependence on God.

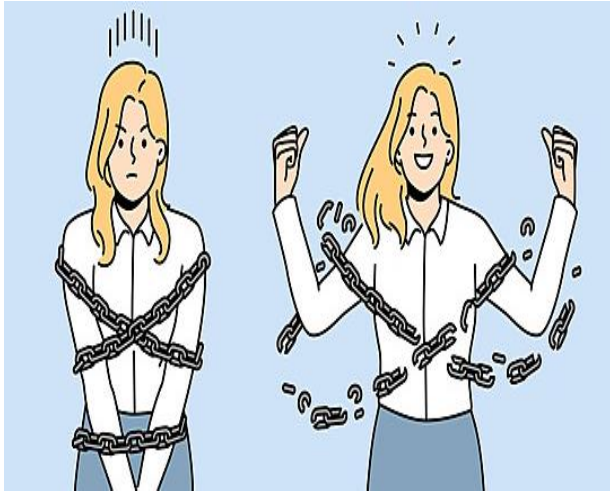
DAY ONE
